

**Atlanta CREW (Climate-Resilience-Environment-Workforce)
Stakeholder Advisory Board Commitment Letter**

The Atlanta CREW Stakeholder Advisory Board members will serve as advisors and partners to Southface, West Atlanta Watershed Alliance, and WonderRoot in the design and execution of the Green Infrastructure (GI) workforce development and implementation program.

Project Commitments:

- Attend monthly meetings for the first three months, and then quarterly meetings thereafter, and be available to provide advice via email and/or telephone.
- Participate in quarterly job fairs for graduates of GI courses (*if applicable*).
- Provide support for: curriculum development; partnership and resource development; GI career pathways; job placement; social enterprise; environmental workforce development.

Project Outcomes:

- Train up to 60 people in green infrastructure installation and operations and maintenance in the City of Atlanta, with priority given to Southwest Atlanta residents.
- Install up to 6 green infrastructure projects in the Utoy Creek Watershed / Southwest Atlanta.
- Increase employment in green infrastructure, with a goal to employ 20 participants by June 2020.
- Engagement and education on the artistic design and implementation of green infrastructure projects.
